

Rotaract Club Of RCCIIT and Rotaract Club of George College jointly took the initiative to supply books and other stationery items to underprivileged children.



ALOHOMORA



 Participants had to register for the event and join the respective event whatsapp groups where they had to send their entries within the mentioned time. Every participant got an E-Participation certificate.





A virtual interaction and a small awareness campaign regarding the importance of menstrual Hygiene was conducted with the students of Sukanya Home through Google meet due to the prevailing Covid -19 pandemic situation. And at Prabartak- BB Block Salt Lake City Kolkata-700064 (near PNB bank) 40 sanitary pads were distributed, also a small awareness campaign was conducted for all the young girls out there.




