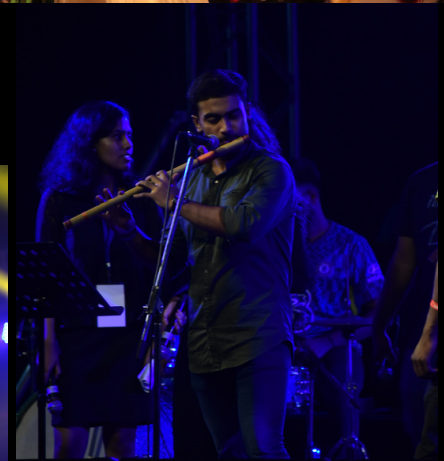

BAND BASH

Date: 27th April 2023
Registration Fees- ₹700

Open Theme

Rules and Regulations:

1. The bands may perform original music and/or covers.
2. Team Size: 4-7 members. At least 1 Vocalist, 2-3 different instruments are required, and cross-college is allowed.
3. Time Limit: 9+2 minutes from an empty stage to an empty stage (including soundcheck).
4. Songs can be of any language (Bengali, Hindi, English). Any swearing on stage will lead to disqualification.
5. Types of equipment provided will be:
 - i. Adequate Microphones
 - ii. Drum Kit
6. All the equipment provided by the college (If any) must be handled with proper care.
7. Bands will have to bring their own musical instruments, brass section, and special effects. However, programmed music is not allowed.
8. A warning bell will be given at the end of 9 minutes.
9. Marks will be deducted for exceeding the time limit.
10. Any form of obscenity or inappropriate behaviour with the management, judges, organizers, and crowd will result in direct disqualification.
11. The final decision regarding any matter lies in the hands of the organizers and judges and is absolutely binding.
12. Team REGALIA reserves the right to make any last-minute changes in the rules and disqualify a team on grounds of misconduct and obscenity.
13. All the participants should be within the range of 18-25 years of age. Participants need to carry age proof documents for verification. the following documents for age verification: Aadhaar card/ PAN card/ college ID.

Rules and Regulations:

4. Multiple teams are allowed per institution.
5. No liquid or sharp objects are allowed on the stage.
6. Organizing committee will not take any responsibility for props/gears.
7. The team must mail their song and prop list to rcciit.regalia.official@gmail.com by 15th April 2023. For safety purposes, it is advised to have the audio in your phone or pen drive.
8. Vulgarity or obscenity will not be tolerated and shall lead to immediate disqualification.
9. Inflammable items are not allowed. The team must clear the stage once they are done with their performance.
10. The performances will be graded according to the judge's score (holding the maximum weightage) and audience reaction.

Rules and Regulations:

1. It is completely a solo event
2. Duration for each performance will be 3 minutes.
3. There will be two rounds prelims and finals.
4. 2 minutes extra will be given before the original performance for setup.
5. Participants are allowed to showcase any of their talents within the given time limit and exceeding this will lead to disqualification.
6. Abusive language and Vulgar slangs and symbols will not be tolerated.
7. Participants have to bring their own props if they require.
8. Usage of fire, any liquid or powdery substance is highly prohibited.
9. The participants need to clear the stage after their performance is over.
10. The participants will be given a warning bell after 3 minutes, they will have to stop their performance.
11. If you are to perform with any pre-recorded music or audio, then you need to mail the audio to the Coordinator and bring the audio with you on your USB Drive or Phone, for safety on the day of the performance.

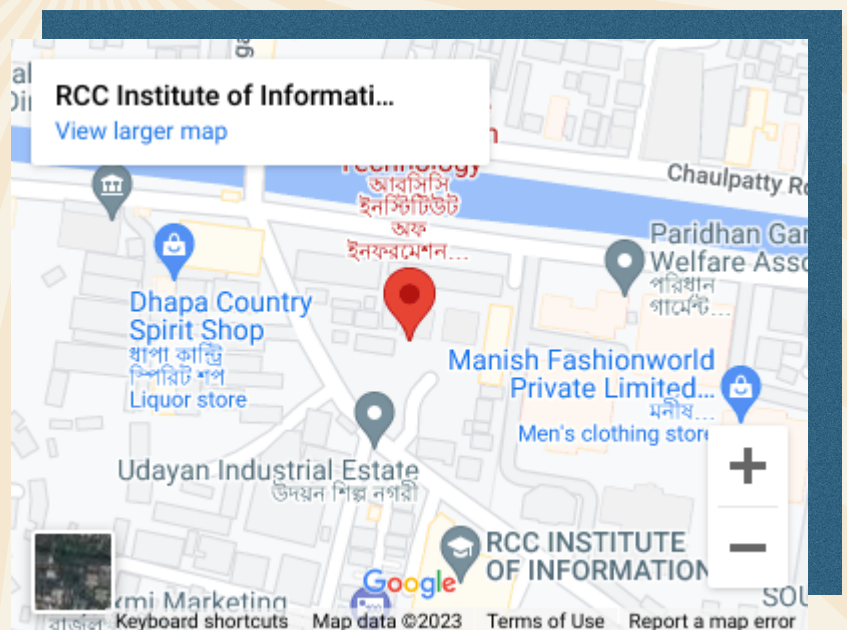
